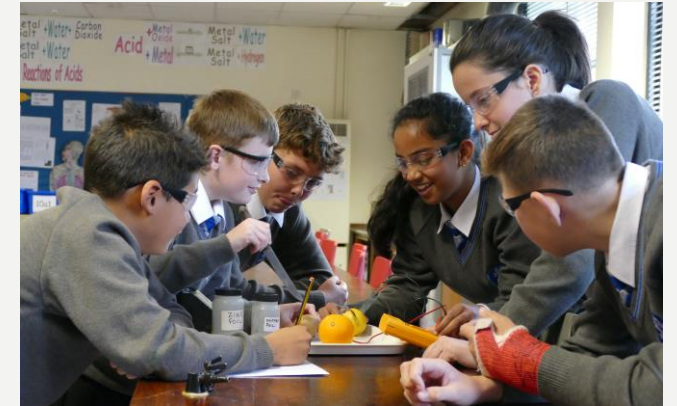

FORM GROUPS AND TEACHING GROUPS



- You are with your **FORM GROUP** today and tomorrow.
- In September you will have lessons with your **TEACHING GROUP** in every subject except for Maths, Welsh/Cymraeg, PE and D&T.
- We run two timetables. We call one the “A” side and one on the “B” side. It means that not everyone will have the same subject at the same time.

MOBILE PHONE POLICY



Phones must be kept on silent and in your bag.

You may not use your phone during the school day – even to check the time. (You may need to get a watch.)

In September if you are seen with a phone you will have to take it to an office and collect it at the end of the day.

If you need to contact home you will be able to do so from your Head of Year's office, from Reception or from the Student Services Office.

KEEPING SAFE

- Once you arrive on school site you cannot leave until the end of the day.
- If you have an appointment your parents/ guardians must let school know beforehand.
- You cannot go to fetch a ball/ go to the shop/ meet friends or family outside the gate during the school day.
- If you are unwell you **MUST** let a member of staff know so that school can contact home. (You must not use your phone to contact them yourself – we need to know if you're ill so that we can help you. We can contact home if we need to.)
- When you are travelling on the buses you **MUST** wear your seatbelt.
- If someone isn't behaving appropriately on the bus then you should let your form tutor know.
- Everything you do/ send/ receive on a computer in school is filtered.

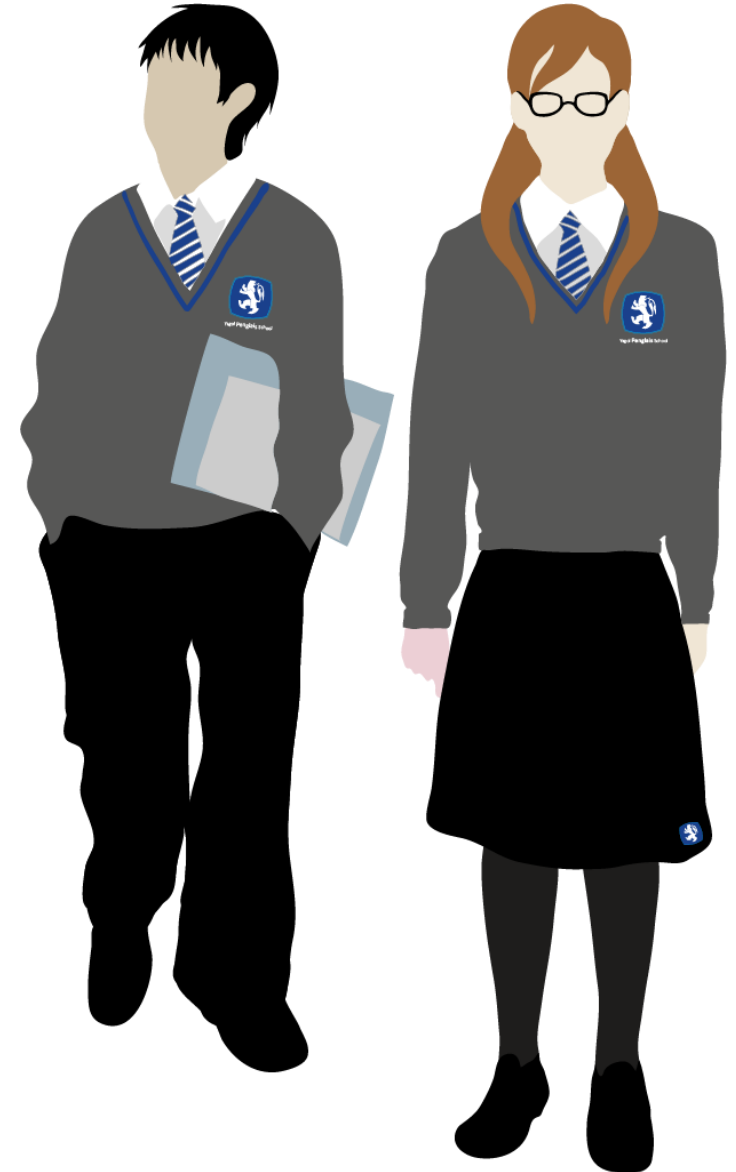

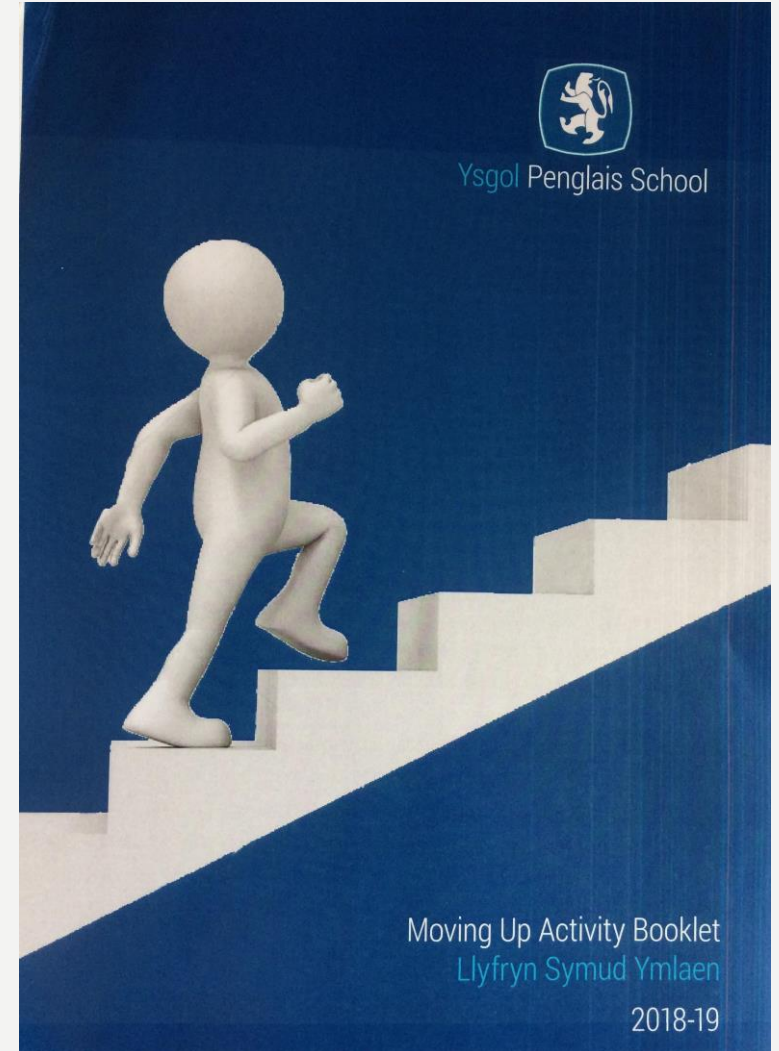
