PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Rugby – Congratulations to Josh Jones, Year 10, who has represented the U15 Ceredigion Rugby team.

Swimming - Alex Thorogood, 10KT came first in the Ceredigion County swimming championship winning the overall points competition for 14 year old girls. Her sister Elinor, 9SE, won a silver and a bronze medal at the same championships.

Cross Country - Both Elinor and Alex Thorogood also ran in the 2005 West Wales Cross Country championships. Elinor finished a very impressive third with Alex in 9th position. Both girls have now been selected to represent West Wales at the Welsh Inter-Regional Cross Country championships in December.

Skiing- On Thursday 19th January the annual Penglais Ski course will depart for Les Deux Alpes in France. We are taking 47 children and everyone concerned is looking forward to it. The ski snowboard course for 2007 is already organised and we will be travelling to Alpe D'Huez, one of the premier resorts in France. Canoeing – In October Gareth and Fiona Farrow were among the 16 junior members of the Wales Canoe Slalom Team that flew to Klagenfurt in Austria to take part in the International Canoe Kayak Slalom Competition, the Alpe-Adrai-Cup. The weather was cold and the white water flowing over the falls at 33 tonnes per second. Fiona was competing in the Junior class against girls up to 18 year olds. She came a creditable 4th. 13 year old Gareth was entered into the Cadet category which is for Under 14s and won his event by 11 hundredths of a second! Congratulations to both of them.




