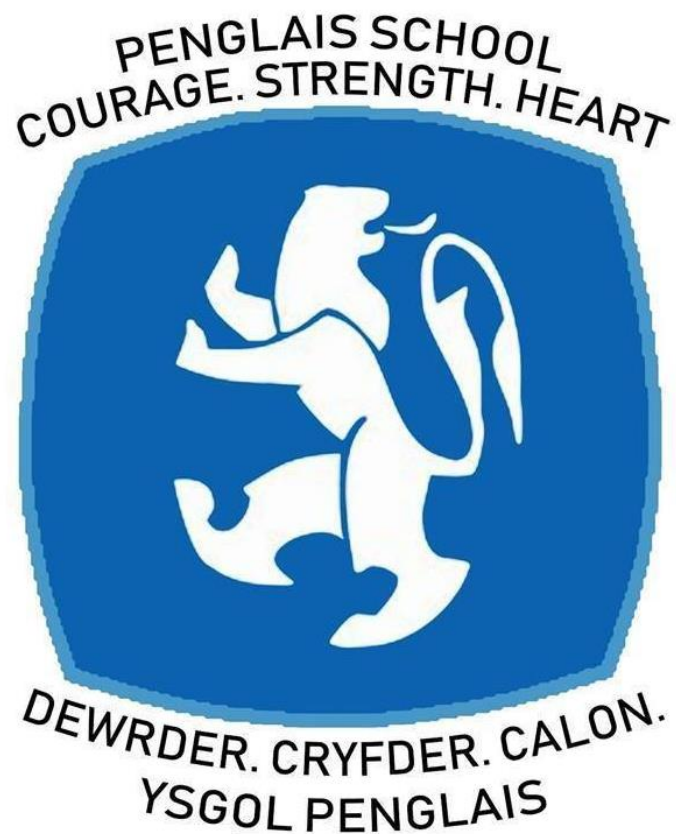

Whole School Assessment Approach 2021

In the absence of formalised exams students will be awarded a Centre Determined Grade (CDG) for their AS Level and BTEC subjects this year. The CDG must be evidence based. The school will implement the following assessment approach to provide evidence of student performance in a subject in a fair, robust and equitable way.

The whole school assessment approach is based on **anchor assessment** and **subsidiary assessments**.

Anchor assessments are assessments that will be delivered between 15th March and 27th May and will be based on the adapted past papers provided by WJEC and any Non- Examination Assessments. The papers will provide teachers with fair, equitable and unbiased assessments and should be based on topics taught to the students. These assessments capture student performance at the end of their learning when they are at their most advanced in terms of knowledge, understanding and skills.

Subsidiary assessments are other assessments that have been carried out throughout the course and may provide other evidence for teachers to use to determine the best-fit grade for the learners; these may include for example, mock exams. Together, the anchor assessments and the subsidiary assessment will provide a consistent and fair base for teachers to be able to evidence standards achieved by learners whilst also giving flexibility to ensure equity for learners.

This booklet provides an overview of the assessments for each AS subject. It should be used to help with organisation in preparation for the assessments.

If you are following qualifications in Business or Travel and Tourism your class teacher will explain the assessment arrangements for these subjects in your lessons.

Your Welsh Bacalaureate teacher will explain the arrangements for this qualification.
